	1. Are you able to do laundry without help?	2	SCN_17_B
	2. Does a disability or health problem keep you from doing laundry?	1	SCN_18_B
<b>LIGHT HOUSEWORK</b>			
	1. Are you able to do light housework such as washing dishes without help?	2	SCN_17_C
	2. Does a disability or health problem keep you from doing light housework?	1	SCN_18_C
<b>SHOP FOR GROCERIES</b>			
	1. Are you able to shop for groceries without help?	2	SCN_17_D
	2. Does a disability or health problem keep you from shopping for groceries?	1	SCN_18_D
<b>MANAGE MONEY</b>			
	1. Are you able to manage money such as keeping track of bills and handling cash without help?	2	SCN_17_E
	2. Does a disability or health problem keep you from managing money?	1	SCN_18_E
<b>TAKE MEDICINE</b>			
	1. Are you able to take medicine without help?	2	SCN_17_F

<b>MAKE PHONE CALLS</b>
